CASH TRANSFER PROGRAM

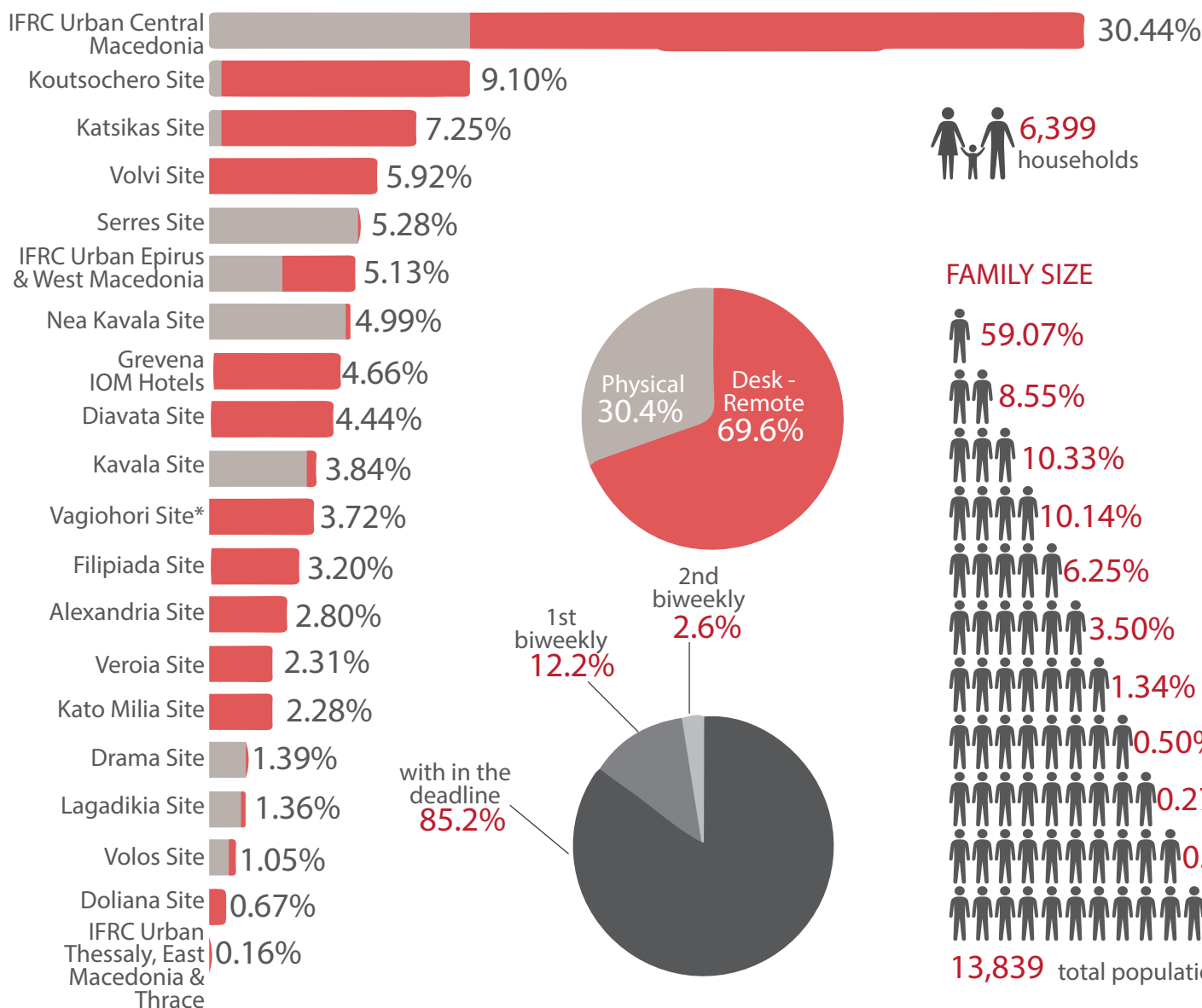
IFRC provides cash assistance to asylum seekers and refugees located in 16 open accommodation facilities, IOM Hotels and various urban locations in North Greece. Cash amounts are based on family size in line with the local social protection system and are provided via a pre-paid card loaded monthly following a certification exercise.

CONTEXT

Certification is conducted on a monthly basis in order to ensure eligibility for cash assistance. IFRC conducts physical certification which requires physical presence

and signature, and desk/remote certification which does not require physical presence as it is based on the RIS/SMS population list confirming physical presence. All locations are physically certified 4 to 10 times per year, while desk-remote certification is conducted in the months between. In addition, IFRC Cash Teams provide helpdesk services and card distribution. Since January 2019, CTP services are also provided at the centrally located Multifunctional Center (MFC) in Thessaloniki in order to promote one stop shop and efficiency services.
