

# IFRC Greece Multi - Functional Centre (MFC) of Thessaloniki

## CONTEXT

To support migrants living in the urban area of Thessaloniki focusing on the self-accommodated who may not otherwise have a support system and to meet their needs related to social inclusion and integration, core services are offered, through the MFC. Three main services are provided: Cash Support Program, Social Services and Restoring Family Links.

## CASH TRANSFER PROGRAM (CTP)

CTP provides cash assistance to self-accommodated asylum seekers and refugees located in Northern Greece and is aimed at supporting persons of concern in meeting their basic needs, based on family size.

## SOCIAL SERVICES

Social Services include initial profiling of all cash eligible and ineligible asylum seekers and provides case management support with peer to peer sessions, Greek language lessons, basic information at the reception area and orientation info group sessions.

## RESTORING FAMILY LINKS (RFL)

RFL involves activities that aim at preventing separation of families and disappearance of individuals, restoring and maintaining contact between family members, and clarifying the fate of persons reported missing as a result of armed conflicts, situations of violence, international migration, and other hardships.

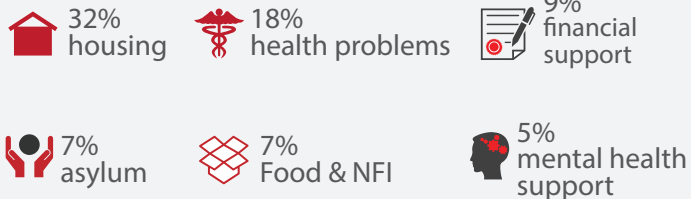
## CTP FIGURES AT THE MFC



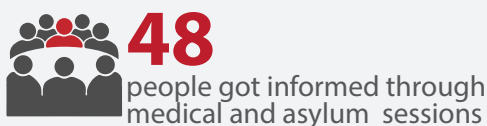
